# Caso VO c. Francia

Demanda no. 53924/00 Decisión 4.06.2004



### Decision ECtHR

"the interpretation of Article 2 in this connection has been informed by a clear desire to strike a balance, and the Convention institutions' position in relation to the legal, medical, philosophical, ethical or religious dimensions of defining the human being has taken into account the various approaches to the matter at national level. This has been reflected in the consideration given to the diversity of views on the point at which life begins, of legal cultures and of national standards of protection, and the State has been left with considerable discretion in the matter"

#### EU secondary legislation

Directive 2004/38/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 29 April 2004 on the right of citizens of the Union and their family members to move and reside freely within the territory of the Member States



Regulation (EC) No 883/2004 on the coordination of social security systems



#### **Categories of EU citizens**

Nationals of an 'old' MS, with freedom of movement

Nationals of a third country, residing in a MS for more than 5 years

Nationals of a 'new' MS, with limited freedom of movement

Nationals of a third country, married with a EU citizen

# Directive 2003/109 <u>status of non-EU</u> <u>nationals who are long-term residents</u>

- Same rights as EU citizens if 2 CONDITIONS
- 1) they should have enjoyed a legal residence in a Member State for at least 5 years (Article 5), and
- 2) they need to have their own medical insurance covering their health and that of their family.



#### Since 2016

- Proposal for a REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on standards for the qualification of **third-country nationals or** stateless persons as beneficiaries of international protection, for a uniform status for refugees or for persons eligible for subsidiary protection and for the content of the protection granted and amending Council Directive 2003/109/EC of 25 November 2003 concerning the status of third-country nationals who are long-term residents,
- COM(2016) 466 final, 13.7.2016



#### In one single document

standards for the qualification of third-country nationals or stateless persons as beneficiaries of international protection

> uniform status for refugees or for persons eligible for subsidiary protection

> > content of the protection granted and amending Council Directive 2003/109/EC of 25 November 2003 concerning the status of third-country nationals who are long-term residents

The right to petition before the European Parliament

#### Art. 227 TFEU

"Any citizen of the Union, and any natural or legal person residing or having its registered office in a Member State, shall have the right to address, individually or in association with other citizens or persons, a petition to the European Parliament on a matter which comes within the Union's fields of activity and which affects him, her or it directly".
